Introducing Team Member Anne White

Anne is the charity's most experienced Play Therapist having been with the charity now for over sixteen years. Here at Kids Cancer Charity, we offer therapeutic support to children and young people up to the age of 19 years who have been affected by cancer in South and South West Wales. We work with children who have been diagnosed with cancer, the siblings of an 'ill child', a child whose parent or close family member has cancer, or a child who has been bereaved through cancer.

Referrals to our service come from a number of sources who are connected with the well being of the family; the doctor, health visitor, social worker, teacher or even directly from the parent. Although Anne is community based visiting children in their own homes, she is also a member of the Paediatric Oncology Team at the Children's Hospital for Wales, Cardiff.

Children and teenagers can find it difficult to deal with the emotional and psychological elements of what has happened/is happening. Ill children can be frightened about what lies ahead and struggle to cope with their everyday tasks such as sleeping. A sibling may feel frustrated and left out and a bereaved child may feel angry at the injustice of the loss. All these emotions can be very hard to handle alone. Play Therapy to a child is what counselling is to an adult. Play to a child offers a natural means of self expression, a freedom of communication without the difficult words. Anne provides the time and emotional space in which a child can play out their emotions, master their demons and retain self control. Anne's car, bulging with toys, games, craft and painting equipment is a much travelled sight around the length of breadth of the coast and up into the valleys and remote mountainside villages of South and West Wales.
